Financial framework

- From 10, 000 € to 30, 000€, according to proposed budget.

- Before the final presentation at *Fabbrica Europa*, a 10 days (max.) residency is planned

in Florence, including a specific budget for technical requirements and accommodation.

## Elements of context, NOW, Labs & partners

**N.O.W** is a European network which aims to build the groundwork for a transnational competency cluster. Starting from a common expertise (managing the implementation of an artistic project and its reception by audiences), the **7 partners** are engaged in an exploration within an experimental setting.

They aim to develop a long-lasting prospective reflection in regards to their artistic and cultural mediation practices.

This experimental structure is made up of **4 labs** that shape the project and determine the **3 years** program of activities.

# LAB 1 - Strengthening producers 'competencies

In order to prospect towards new development paths, this reflexive lab will be mapping, the skills we have all developed in regards to respective national contexts and we will examine how they affect our jobs.

**LAB 2 - A management structure based on networks;** 5 artists will be accompanied by 2 to 3 partners over a period of 1, 5 year, allowing an open exchange between the parties and allowing artists to work on specific issues of their choice.

# LAB 3 - Innovating tools of production: investigating commission

A commission will be written by the partners and the proposal sent to a selected group of artists. This framework will allow the commissioners to stay in contact with the artist during the process and aid its implementation:

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**LAB 4 - Outreach and representation tools as restitution of the creative process** Over the working sessions hosted by the seven partners, local artists and operators will be invited to expose their research and or practices in order to guide us in approaching the issues related to the restitution of the creative process. The documentation of the commission will be also experimented within this lab.
